REGION 3 REPORT – BY MICHELLE GAGNE

REGION 3 DELEGATE MEETING Friday, November 17, 2011

The November meeting was held at the AHA convention in Vancouver, BC. Jill Cohn who handles the PR for the region is still looking for pictures to use for publicity. She would like non horseshow pictures. Pictures of adults and kids enjoying their Arabians and Half Arabians are preferred. She you like them in jpeg or pdf format. The 2012 Regional shows are scheduled for July 8^{th} -14th. All the judges are currently under contract. The 2012 Sport Horse Championship show will be June 30th through July 1st. The show date has moved back 1 week from 2010 and will again be held in conjunction with the CNASH show.

Rick Harnden reported about the state of the Region 3 Web site. Everything was ready to go. However when he uploaded the new web site system to the server it didn't work. So he's back to the computer to fit it. He plans to get it fixed and up and running within a month.

One area that the Market Development/Promotion committee is looking at is the academy division. Promotion classes in this division saved the Saddlebreds. With fewer people owning horses offering academy classes allows non horse owners to complete on school horses against their other non-horse owners. The Market Development committee has been restricted in what they have been able to do because of budget constraints. Their funding comes from the registration fees and as with all the horse breeds, registration have been down.

At the September Region 3 meeting the board was told of requests to hold Region 3 shows outside of Region 3 with reciprocal regional shows being held within Region 3. The Red Bluff club asked for approval to sponsor a Region 3 show in Region 4 (Oregon/Idaho) and host a reciprocal show with their show. This was approved. However Region 4 turned down Red Bluffs and Comstock's request to host Region 4 shows.

AHANC requested to host a Region 3 show in Region 2. They are planning to host a Region 2 show with their show. This was put to a vote before the Region 3 board. It was past but not unanimous. Diablo was very concerned how this is going to affect their show, especially after having cancelled this year's show.

The next Region 3 meeting will be Friday February 3, 2012, 8pm, at the Courtyard by Marriott in Vacaville. There will be Region 3 show committee show meeting at 6:30 preceding the Regional meeting.

2011 AHA CONVENTION November 16-19, 2011 Vancouver, BC

As the delegate for Gold Coast AHA, I attended the AHA convention in Vancouver, BC. When I attend the convention I try and get to as many committee meetings as I can to learn the issues and understand the concerns of the different committees and division within AHA. Unfortunately many of the committee meetings are scheduled at the same time. This year I attended the following committee meetings, the Working Western Committee, the Market Development & Promotion Committee, AHA Futurity Commission, the Hunter/Jumper Committee, the Membership Committee, USEF Arabian Division Rules Committee, the Pacific Slopes Committee and the Amateur Committee. I also attended the following forums, the Adequan Forum, the Barn Fire Safety & Prevention Forum, the Meet the Candidates Forum and the Resolution Plenary Session.

This convention was very low keyed. There was not a lot of information to be gathered at many of the committee meetings. Many of the committee meetings were extremely short with little being discussed. This was a bit of a disappointment as at past conventions I really got a feel for the concerns of these different committees and their areas of interest. One exception was the Working Western Committee. Look for a complete rewrite in the USEF Arabian rules section for the Working Western division. Presented in this committee was a single page of rules for this division, as all the rules, patterns, scoring and judging for the Working Cow and Reined Cow classes are governed by NRCHA rules. Also there were new class procedures that covered Sections, Go's for Reining, Trail, Working Cow and Reined Cow classes at the Nationals. These changes were approved by the AHA Board at their meeting there at the Convention. I certainly learned what I didn't know about cattle contracted for shows, cattle contractors, cattle numbers needed and how the cattle could or should be used by a show. In the Reining classes they are looking at offering Limited Open and Limited Non Pro etc. (The same divisions offered by NRHA).

In the Hunter/Jumper Committee meeting the discussion surrounded the Sport Horse Nationals. AHA will be issuing a national class number for 14.2 and under Jumper classes. This class will be an exhibition class in 2012. At the Canadian Nationals there were 26 Amateur to Handle Sport Horses. The 2012 Sport Horse Nationals will be held at Nampa, Idaho. The 2013 Sport Horse Nationals will be held at Lexington, Virginia. If the number of entries at the Idaho venue drops, then Nampa may loose the date in the future.

<u> 2011 AHA CONVENTION - November 16-19, 2011 - CONTINUED</u>

The Market Development & Promotion Committee has not had a lot of funds to underwrite their programs what with the commitment to the Arabian Horse Museum. Their funding comes from registrations and as you know registrations have been down. Their main focus is on getting the AHA website more user friendly. They feel that have done a good job in the past years of getting the Arabian horse out to the non Arabian horse owner via non Arabian magazine ads, horse expos etc. However they have then lost these people when they tried to go the AHA website and navigate around. These potential new Arabian owners are then lost because they are so frustrated!

The Amateur committee discussed a couple of rules with regards to the Select Amateur classes. They wanted one of two rules put in to clarify who can assist a Select Amateur. Their suggestions were 1. A Select Amateur can be assisted by any amateur other that an amateur family member of a trainer. 2. Any amateur can help any amateur. The other item they discussed was the changing of the definition of Amateur Owner to allow multiple non related amateurs to own and show a horse in the Amateur Owner classes.

Points from the Speeches of

AHA President Lance Walters, EVP Glenn Petty and Bruce Johnson's speeches.

- Membership and registration still declining but less then expected and better than many breeds.
- In 2013 will budget \$15,000 to help farms, breeders, clubs etc to drive membership.
- Youth National had lower numbers then previous years because of lower AHA membership.
- Youth National budgeted for 888 horses and got 940.
- There will be \$25,000 budgeted in 2013 for youth programs. In the recent past AHA has not participated in 4H or FAA activities but they need to get involved again. The FAA convention had 30,000+ attendees.
- Sport Horse Nationals the numbers were up. Budgeted for 500 horses and got 536.
- Sport Horse Nationals will rotate over the next 4 years between Idaho and Lexington, Virginia.
- Canadian Nationals exceeded expectations and it looks like they will have a \$77,000 profit.
- At the Canadian Nationals Ray Don Arabians will sponsor the PB yearling colt and PB yearling filly classes for the next 5 years at \$15,000 per class and will sponsor the HA yearling Colt and HA yearling Filly classes at \$5,000 per class.
- U.S. Nationals budgeted for 1725 horses and got 1805.
- Halter classes at the U.S. Nationals had 493 entries, up from 200 in 2010.
- Tulsa will support the U.S. Nationals to the tune of \$200,000 for 2012. If AHA signs a 5 years contract with Tulsa then Tulsa will support the U.S. National at \$500,000 per year for the 5 years..
- It is estimated that the U.S. Nationals brings Tulsa about \$34 million dollars.
- The Youth judging at the U.S. Nationals is the oldest judging competition and one of the biggest.
- The 2011 Competitive/Endurance Rides were a success and will be held again in 2012.
- 95 Sires were nominated to the Sweepstakes program this year. This compares to 184 entered over the previous 4 years.
- The average age of the current Arabian breeding mares is 18.
- Not enough Arabians are being registered to replace the aging breeding mares.
- Arizona will be out of horse hay by May 2012. Large hay quantities are being shipped to Asia.
- There are currently 249 Arabian clubs nation wise.
- In 2008 there were 4953 PB registration, 2009 had 4395, 2010 had 3818 and as of Oct. 2011 there were 3010 registered. All the breeds have shown decreasing numbers in registrations.
- We need to look at offering Academy classes and programs. This saved the Saddlebred breed.
- The largest horse show in the country is the Fort Worth Reicker Show (AQHA), in 2012 they are adding an Arabian division to their show.
- AHA sanctioned 328 Arabian shows and 26 one day shows in 2011.
- The AHA magazine has made close to a 6 figure profit.
- Stan Morey, the Judges commissioner, reported that AHA has 261 licensed judges and 141 licensed stewards.

There were 486 delegates eligible to attend the convention. 266 were in attendance.

The 2012 convention will be in Lexington, KY.

The 2013, 2014 and 2015 conventions will be held in Denver, CO
