



REGION 3 DELEGATE MEETING REPORT - SEPTEMBER 7, 2012

The third meeting of the year was held at the Courtyard by Marriott in Vacaville. Kari Albiol is looking for non show pictures to use for breed promotion. Anyone having photos that would like to share should contact her. (karia723@msncom).

Sharon Richards cover the Region 3 pre show and the Championship shows held this past July. The shows were down about 46 horses from 2011. The entries were also down by 331. Some of the shows expenses were also down. With less horses there were less stalls used. The cost for lodging was up. Also this year the show had not only to pay to have sand added to the areas but also had to pay to have the added sand removed. Some of the rented plants (9) died and cost the show \$300. The cost for the judges was also up by \$1,000 for luggage charges. The exhibitors that did come brought fewer horses and didn't ride in as many pre show classes. The 2012 show finished with a total profit of about \$2614. The show was budgeted for a \$20,000 profit. Region 3 has two more years on the contract with the Reno Livestock Center. There was some talk about possibly looking to move the show after the contract is up. The show dates for 2013 are July 7 through July 14th.

Sharon also gave a preliminary report of the Region 3 Sport Horse Championship show. It was again held in conjunction with the CNASHA show. The show had a total of 100 horses and a class entry of 360. This was up from a 2011 horse count of 80 and an entry count of 232. It was believed that the entries at the Sport Horse Regional's were up because the US National show will be in Nampa ID this year. The financial report based on current checks written and deposits made to the horse show account show a loss of \$7372. However because the championship show was held with another show there is still some splitting of costs and income. The show manager of the Region 3 Sport Horse Championship show believes that the finals report will show a profit of about \$4,000.

There was also talk about some other issues in the Arabian show world. 100 is the average size of AHA approved shows across the nation. Also it was mentioned that one AHA region is close to filing bankruptcy. One bad show and they will probably go under. It was not stated what region is in this state.

Steve Freeman let the directors know about some of the goings on at AHA. Show Secretaries now have the ability to verify horse names, numbers and owners on line. The new AHA website is not going well. Different parts of the website are in different computer languages and this is making it slow going to get everything that AHA wants done on the website. Plus it adds to the cost to get things done. On the positive site the AHA Financial report is completed and ready to go to the printers. This is a real accomplishment as the AHA Financial report is usually never done before the annual convention. And the ink is still wet at that time. AHA is also looking at the direct memberships. AHA wants to assign direct membership to local clubs if one is not selected with a direct membership. AHA is looking at maybe the only direct membership available being for a farm membership. Membership will be a topic at this year's convention. AHA is also looking at the possibility of changing the number of eligible delegates to conventions from one delegate for every 50 club members to one delegate for every 30 club members. The Youth Nationals did not meet there budgeted horse count nor their entry numbers. The show will still make a profit but not the profit budgeted for. The Sport Horse Nationals is also not going to meet their budgeted horse count. The show was budgeted for 400 horses and it will not make that horse count or the budgeted entry numbers.

Under new business there was a request for approval to hold Region 3 shows out of the region. Santa Barbara wants to again hold a Region 3 show in May 2013 with AHANC holding a Reciprocal Region 2 show. Las Vegas also requested approval for a Region 3 show with a non specified show date, maybe April. Las Vegas is willing to offer a Reciprocal show date if asked. Region 3 approved the May date with AHANC holding the reciprocal show again for 2013. They did not approve the Las Vegas show date. Las Vegas needs to provide more information on the hosting club and show dates before Region 3 will reconsider their request.

Under Club Announcements, Golden Gate reported that they had only 1 trail horse complete at their show because the Region 2 trainer that normally comes to their show and brings a number of trail horses to their show competed at the Region 3 show held in region 2. DAHA reported they were down about 20 horses, mostly in the working western division. AHANC might be moving their show by a week. The facility that they use has asked them to move because the facility has another breed show that wants that date.

The next Region 3 directors meeting will be at the AHA convention in Denver. Submitted by Delegate Michelle Gagne
