

GOLD COAST AHA SCHOOLING SHOW RULES:

- 1) The safety of both the rider and the horse is of paramount importance.
- 2) **NOTE:** In Lead Line Classes the leading rein must be attached to a halter or cavesson only.
- 3) Formal show attire is not necessary. However, the following is required:
 - a) Long pants, shirts with sleeves, and heeled riding boots or shoes are required in all classes.
- 4) Hard hats and safety helmets are acceptable in all classes.
- 5) A **Limit horse** is one who has not won more than six (6) blue ribbons in any rated show in that division.
- 6) A **Novice horse** is one who has not won more than three blue ribbons in any rated show in that division.
- 7) **Beginner rider** classes are restricted to riders that are just beginning their show career or are returning to the show world after a long absence. Experienced show riders are restricted from this show division.
- 8) Required gaits will be walk, trot and canter, or walk, jog and lope unless noted. Extensions may be required.
- 9) Acceptable schooling devices include snaffles, martingales, cavessons, and hackamores.
- 10) Leg wraps are acceptable. Riding 2 handed is OK.
- 11) **Exhibitors may ride in non-eligible classes by turning their number upside down. You will not be judged in that class.**
- 12) The judge's decision is final.
- 13) The show committee reserves the right to combine, cancel, divide, or add classes.
- 14) The two-minute gate rule will be enforced.
- 15) Ribbons will be awarded 1st thru 5th.
- 16) **FOOD WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE** at this show.
- 17) **THORSON ARENA RULES:** *Help us continue to be able to use these facilities.*
 - a) All children under 10 years of age **MUST** wear helmets.
 - b) You must clean up after your horse.
 - c) No cleaning out of trailers in the parking lot or on the grounds.
 - d) Pick up all manure, feed, and shavings from around your trailer before leaving.

NOTE: This schooling show will use the Ticket System.

TICKET SYSTEM:

ALL TICKET SALES ARE FINAL ONCE YOU LEAVE THE OFFICE.

Each entry fee will purchase you one ticket. Each ticket is good for entrance into ANY class of your choice. Simply present your ticket at the entry gate and enter the class.

Unused tickets purchased at the first schooling show are good for the shows offered in the balance of the series.

DIRECTIONS TO THORSON'S ARENA:

SOUTHBOUND

Take TENNANT AVE exit west; turn left on MONTEREY ROAD; right on WATSONVILLE ROAD; follow 2 miles to WATSONVILLE COURT. Facility will be on your left.

NORTHBOUND

Take SAN MARTIN AVE exit west; turn right on SANTA THERESA BOULEVARD; turn left on WATSONVILLE ROAD at the 4-way stop go straight ahead; follow to WATSONVILLE COURT. Facility will be on your left.
